

241.100 Disqualification of board members and employees of office.

- (1) No member of the board or member of his immediate family or employee of the office shall have any interest in any premises or business where alcoholic beverages are manufactured, stored or sold. Nor shall he receive any commission or profit from any person applying for or receiving any license or permit.
- (2) No person shall be disqualified under this section solely by reason of his membership in a club.
- (3) If a member of the board is disqualified or fails to give bond and take the oath of office, the Governor shall fill the vacancy by appointment for the period during which that member of the board remains disqualified or fails to qualify.
