

**82.705 Local government authorized to enact nuisance code.**

A local government may, by ordinance, enact a nuisance code and impose penalties for violation of the nuisance code. The violations may be enforced with criminal penalties or a local government may, by ordinance, elect to enforce violations with civil penalties pursuant to the procedures set forth in KRS 82.710, 82.720, and 82.725.

Section 17 of that Act provided that the repeal of statutes in Section 18 of that Act "shall not be interpreted or otherwise construed to affect the status, priority, or enforcement of any lien that was created and existed pursuant to the provisions of KRS 82.725 or KRS 381.770 prior to January 1, 2017."
