

336.180 "Labor organization" defined.

As used in KRS 336.190 and 336.200, unless the context requires otherwise, the term "labor organization" means any organization of any kind, or any agency or employee representation committee or plan, in which employees participate and which exists for the purpose, in whole or in part, of dealing with employers concerning grievances, labor disputes, wages, rates of pay, hours of employment or conditions of work.
