

12 KAR 1:175. Seed certification in Kentucky.

RELATES TO: KRS 250.081(1)(c)1

STATUTORY AUTHORITY: KRS 250.081

NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: To prescribe the procedure for certifying seed for varietal purity in Kentucky. Certification assures genetic identity and purity of superior plant varieties.

Section 1. Certification Procedure. (1) The procedures and standards established in the Kentucky Certified Seed Handbook shall be applied to all seed certified in Kentucky.
