

A RESOLUTION adjourning the House of Representatives in honor and loving memory of Dr. Don L. Notter D.V.M.

WHEREAS, Dr. Notter was born on May 1, 1935, the cherished son of the late Daniel A. and Sadie M. McMahon Notter; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Notter graduated from the Ohio State College of Veterinary Medicine, completed his internship at the Woodford Veterinary Clinic, operated his own practice in Harrodsburg from 1965 until 1988, and served as State Veterinarian for the Kentucky Department of Agriculture from 1988 until 2004; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Notter was the longest-serving State Veterinarian. Under his expertise, Kentucky received free status for pseudorabies in swine from the United States Department of Agriculture in 1997, and in that same year was awarded free status for brucellosis in cattle; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Notter departed this earthly life on January 10, 2016, leaving his family, friends, and all those whose lives he touched in solemn mourning; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Notter was preceded in death by his twin brother, Dr. Danny Notter D.V.M., and sister, Bette Hammer. He is survived by his wife, Donna Frownfelter Notter; daughters, Lori N. Wimmer and her husband, Robert, and Jennifer N. Deibert and her husband, Paul; son, L. Brent Notter; grandchildren, Courtney W. McCracken, Morgan L. Wimmer, Hannah K. Wimmer, Katelyn M. Deibert, Sara K. Deibert, James Daniel Notter, and Cory A. Hurst; and great-grandchild, Callan L. McCracken;
