

A JOINT RESOLUTION designating the "Jimmy Doran Memorial Bridge" in Greenup County.

WHEREAS, Jimmy Doran, a lifelong resident of the city of Greenup, was born on November 29, 1934, to the late James Blaine and Sue Terrill Doran, and traversed these earthly bounds on November 8, 2011; and

WHEREAS, Jimmy Doran was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, Hazel Frazier Doran; and his brother, Nicholas Terrill Doran; and

WHEREAS, Jimmy Doran is survived by his son, Phillip Wendle Doran of Greenup; his daughter, Karen Faith Doran of Greenup; and his brother and sister-in-law, Roger Terry Doran and Judy Doran of Greenup; and

WHEREAS, Jimmy Doran was a graduate of Greenup Independent High School, class of 1953, and was retired from Allied Chemical, Ironton Coke, and Pathways Inc.; and

WHEREAS, Jimmy Doran was a former mayor and council member of the city of Greenup and was very proud to be instrumental in the procurement of the city park and the supplying of water to many residents of Greenup County; and

WHEREAS, Jimmy Doran was a former chief of the Greenup Fire Department, president of the Riverview Cemetery Association, a charter member of the Greenup Jaycees, past president of the Greenup Lions Club, a Little League baseball and basketball coach, a Kentucky Colonel, and Elder of the Greenup Presbyterian Church; and

WHEREAS, Jimmy Doran provided decades of service to the city of Greenup; and

WHEREAS, in 2003, the Transportation Cabinet closed the 127-year-old one-lane bridge across the Little Sandy. Jimmy Doran believed the bridge was the lifeline to the city of Greenup and, until his last day, fought to have it replaced; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly sees fit to honor the life, public service, and memory of Jimmy Doran through this designation;

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet is hereby directed to designate the Little Sandy River Bridge in Greenup County, which connects Kentucky Route 2541 (Main Street) and United States Route 23, as the "Jimmy Doran Memorial Bridge," and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signs denoting this designation.
