On page 1, line 20, by deleting "police officer,"; and

On page 1, line 10, after "firefighter", by deleting " "; and

On page 3, by deleting lines 22 to 27 in their entirety and inserting the following:

"(5) An authorized staff physician, as defined in KRS 202A.011, may order the admission of the person to permit a qualified health professional to complete the assessment and discharge plan required by this section.

(6) Any person brought to an appropriate facility under subsection (5) of this section shall be released from the facility within seventy-two (72) hours, excluding weekends and holidays, unless further detained by other applicable law or for further voluntary treatment.

(7) The Justice and Public Safety Cabinet and the Office of Drug Control Policy may promulgate administrative regulations in accordance with KRS Chapter 13A to administer and implement this section.

(8) The Department for Behavioral Health, Developmental and Intellectual Disabilities shall collect data, in compliance with the federal Health Insurance Portability and
