SUBJECT: 2017 Interim Joint Committee Regular Meeting Schedule

DATE: November 16, 2016

KRS 7.103(1)(a) authorizes the Legislative Research Commission to approve a monthly interim joint committee meeting schedule. Assumptions and caveats:

1. Italicized committees are statutory committees that may meet on any day of the month without approval of an alternate date, except the statutory guidelines for the Administrative Regulation Review Subcommittee and the Government Contract Review Committee require them to meet before the 15th of each month. There is no “typical” meeting day for the Medicaid Oversight and Advisory Committee, which is only required to meet four times annually. The Consensus Forecasting Group, which is also a statutory committee, is not listed on the calendar because it has no legislative members. The Education Assessment and Accountability Review Subcommittee and the Capital Planning Advisory Board are scheduled to meet at 10 a.m. each month because currently there are no member conflicts. If conflicts arise in 2017, the times could be adjusted.
2. The calendar does not reflect scheduling for any task forces or special committees that may be authorized by LRC or the 2017 General Assembly.
3. The calendar does not reflect travel time involved with known or unknown out-of-town meetings.
4. Northern Kentucky typically sponsors an event (Northern Kentucky United) each June. We do not know if that event will be held in 2017. Depending on the date and whether specific committees are invited, there could be conflict.
5. The Interim Joint Committee on Judiciary typically rotates conducting a meeting in conjunction with the Prosecutors Advisory Council’s conference and the Department for Public Advocacy’s (DPA) Public Defender Conference. If this rotation remains the same, Judiciary would meet during DPA’s conference, which is set for June 19-20. The calendar has not been adjusted for that conference because Judiciary has not always met during that conference, the co-chairs have not expressed intent to meet during the conference in 2017, and the meeting day and time would need to be coordinated with DPA. However, the meeting could be held on June 19 without any conflicts because there are no other meetings scheduled for that day.
6. The Interim Joint Committee on Labor and Industry’s September meeting is rescheduled to meet in conjunction with the Kentucky Labor Management Conference, September 12-14, 2017. To minimize conflicts and to accommodate statutory mandates, Government Contracts’ and Administrative Regulations’ meetings have been moved to September 11. The Education Committee’s meeting on September 11 has been moved to September 18.
7. There may be conflicts if subcommittees are approved for committees.
8. The Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue’s subcommittees will meet throughout the interim.
9. The Interim Joint Committee on Education’s subcommittees will meet throughout the interim.
10. The Interim Joint Committee on Agriculture’s subcommittees’ will only meet in November. The committee typically meets in conjunction with the State Fair, and this date has been accommodated by moving Agriculture to that date and, to avoid conflicts, by moving Appropriations and Revenue to August 29. The committee typically meets during the University of Kentucky’s Agricultural Roundup—typically held in September or October--but the dates for the 2017 Roundup have not been set as of September 2016.
11. There is no Election Day in November 2017.
