

82.710 Requirements for local government nuisance code.

Any local government electing to enact a nuisance code and enforce violations of the nuisance code as civil violations shall enact an ordinance or ordinances which:

- (1) Establish the acts, actions, behavior, or conditions which constitute violations;
- (2) Establish reasonable standards and procedures for the enforcement of the nuisance code;
- (3) Provide for the establishment of a hearing board and hearing officers and the procedures to be followed by the hearing board and hearing officers;
- (4) Delegate responsibility for enforcement of the nuisance code to an agency or department of the local government; and
- (5) Establish penalties to be imposed upon persons determined to have violated the nuisance code.

Legislative Research Commission Note (7/15/2016). The repeal of this statute in 2016 Ky. Acts ch. 86, sec. 18 is effective January 1, 2017. Section 17 of that Act provided that the repeal of statutes in Section 18 of that Act "shall not be interpreted or otherwise construed to affect the status, priority, or enforcement of any lien that was created and existed pursuant to the provisions of KRS 82.725 or KRS 381.770 prior to January 1, 2017."
