"Written informed request" is a form which shall be prepared and distributed by the State Board of Medical Licensure and shall be in substance as follows:

**WRITTEN INFORMED REQUEST FOR PRESCRIPTION OF AMYGDALIN
(Laetrile) FOR MEDICAL TREATMENT AND RELEASE OF PHYSICIAN FROM
LIABILITY**

Malignancy, disease, illness or physical condition diagnosed for medical treatment by amygdalin (laetrile):

My physician has explained to me:

- (a) That the manufacture and distribution of amygdalin (laetrile) has been banned by the Federal Food and Drug Administration.
- (b) That neither the American Cancer Society, the American Medical Association, nor the Kentucky Medical Association recommend use of amygdalin (laetrile) in the treatment of any malignancy, disease, illness, or physical condition.
- (c) That I am terminally ill and there are alternative recognized treatments for the malignancy, disease, illness, or physical condition from which I suffer which he has offered to provide for me including: (here describe).....

That notwithstanding the foregoing, I hereby request prescription and use of amygdalin (laetrile) in the medical treatment of the malignancy, disease, illness, or physical condition from which I suffer.

I hereby release the physician from any and all liability due to any deleterious consequences that may be directly attributable to the use of amygdalin (laetrile).
