

323A.110 Grounds for revocation or suspension.

- (1) The board may suspend or revoke the license of any landscape architect to practice landscape architecture in the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and may impose a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100) nor more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) per violation, for any of the following reasons:
 - (a) Gross incompetency or gross negligence in planning or designing the development of land areas, as determined by the board;
 - (b) Unprofessional conduct, or conduct tending to bring the profession into disrepute, as determined by the board;
 - (c) Conviction of a felony;
 - (d) Fraudulent or dishonest landscape architectural practice;
 - (e) Use of false evidence or misrepresentations in an application for license;
 - (f) Signing or affixing his seal to any plans, prints, specifications, or reports which have not been prepared by him personally or under his immediate supervision;
 - (g) Failure to meet the continuing education requirements established by administrative regulation of the board.
- (2) The board shall revoke the license of a landscape architect who practices landscape architecture while his license is inactive or suspended.
